

USER INSTRUCTIONS

Please read these instructions carefully and familiarise yourself with your New SUNBEAM DELUXE FOOD PROCESSOR AND BLENDER before first use.

- POWER
- •230V ~ 50Hz 600W
- Ensure that the voltage indicated on the identification plate corresponds with the mains voltage.
- FITTING OF 3 PIN PLUG

WARNING - THIS APPLIANCE MUST BE EARTHED

IMPORTANT: the wires in this mains lead are coloured in accordance with the following code:

Blue - Neutral Brown - Live

As the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows:-

The wire which is coloured **blue** must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter 'N' or coloured **black**.

The wire which is coloured **brown** must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter **'L'** or coloured **red.**

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY - ALWAYS MAINTAIN SAFETY WHEN WORKING WITH ANY APPLIANCE

- . Check that the mains voltage corresponds with the rating of the appliance before operating.
- . Never place hands or objects into the Jar while the unit is in operation.
- . Take care when handling the cutting blades.
- . Never immerse the Motor Base in water.
- . To protect against electric shock, do not immerse cords, plugs or appliances in water or any other liquid.

- To disconnect remove the plug from the outlet. Do not pull plug out by the cord.

- Do not introduce any foreign objects into the housing or try to open the housing yourself.
- Ensure hands are dry before operating or plugging in.
- Ensure that the unit is set on a flat, even surface.
- Do not operate when the cups are empty and do not remove the Cup Covers before the Blade comes to a complete stop.
- Do not touch the **Cutting Blades** or insert any kind of object (knives, forks, spoons) into the **Cups** while in operation. A Spatula may be used only when the product is not in operation.
- The Processor Cup (10) should not be removed while the Blender Cup (4) is being used, and when using the Processor Cup (10), the Blender Cup (4) or Lid (16) must be attached.
- Switch off the appliance before changing accessories.
- ENSURE THAT ALL LIDS ARE LOCKED INTO PLACE (This engages the Micro-Switches without which the unit will not operate)

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Before first use :

- · All parts of the unit should be thoroughly cleaned before first use (see Section : Cleaning)
- Before inserting the **Blender and Processor Cups** to the housing, ensure that the **Power Cord** is plugged in and the **Speed Knob** (5) is set to '0'.

WHEN USING THE FOOD PROCESSOR:

- When you use the Food Processor, ensure that the Blender Cup (4) or Lid (16) is attached.
 Place the Lid on the Processor Cup (10) and turn counter-clockwise until you hear it lock into place. (This engages the Micro-Switch)
- To chop the food into strips: Place the Blade Tray (11) on to the Rotor (15). Place the prepared food in the Processor Cup (10) and set to the desired speed. Press the Processor Push
- Cover (8) downward until the food is completely chopped.

 To chop the food into pieces: Place the Blade tray (11) on to the Rotor (15) (Ensure the strip blade faces
- downwards). Operate the same way as chopping into strips.

 To chop hard pieces of food: Place the Stainless Steel Blade (12) on to the Rotor (15) and operate as above.
- To mix the food : Place the Plastic Plate (7) on to the Rotor (15) and operate as above.

WHEN USING THE BLENDER:

- Remove the Blender Cup Cover (2) from the Blender Cup (4) by pressing the Cover Release Button (3) on the handle and turning the cover counter-clockwise.
- Place the items to be blended into the **Blender Cup (4)** and replace the **Blender Cup Cover (2)** by turning it clockwise until you hear it click. (This engages the Micro-Switch)
- Set the Speed knob (5) to the desired position, turning it clockwise.
- After items have been successfully blended, remove the Blender Cup (4) by pressing the Cover Release Button (3) on the handle down and turning the Blender Cup Cover (2) clockwise to unlock and remove.
- Turn the Blender Cup (4) clockwise and remove from the Base (6).


NOTES:

- ENSURE THAT ALL LIDS ARE LOCKED INTO PLACE (This engages the Micro-Switches)
- Only use the appliance for 1 minute at a time, letting it rest for every other minute.
- Ensure the Speed Knob (5) is reset to '0' and the unit is unplugged when not in use.
- · This 2 in 1 appliance can also crush ice.

CLEANING THE UNIT:

- · After using the unit, unplug from outlet and detach assembly. Clean with detergent, do not use abrasive products.
- Do not use in dishwasher, do not submerse Base (Motor Unit). Clean outside with a soft, dry cloth.
